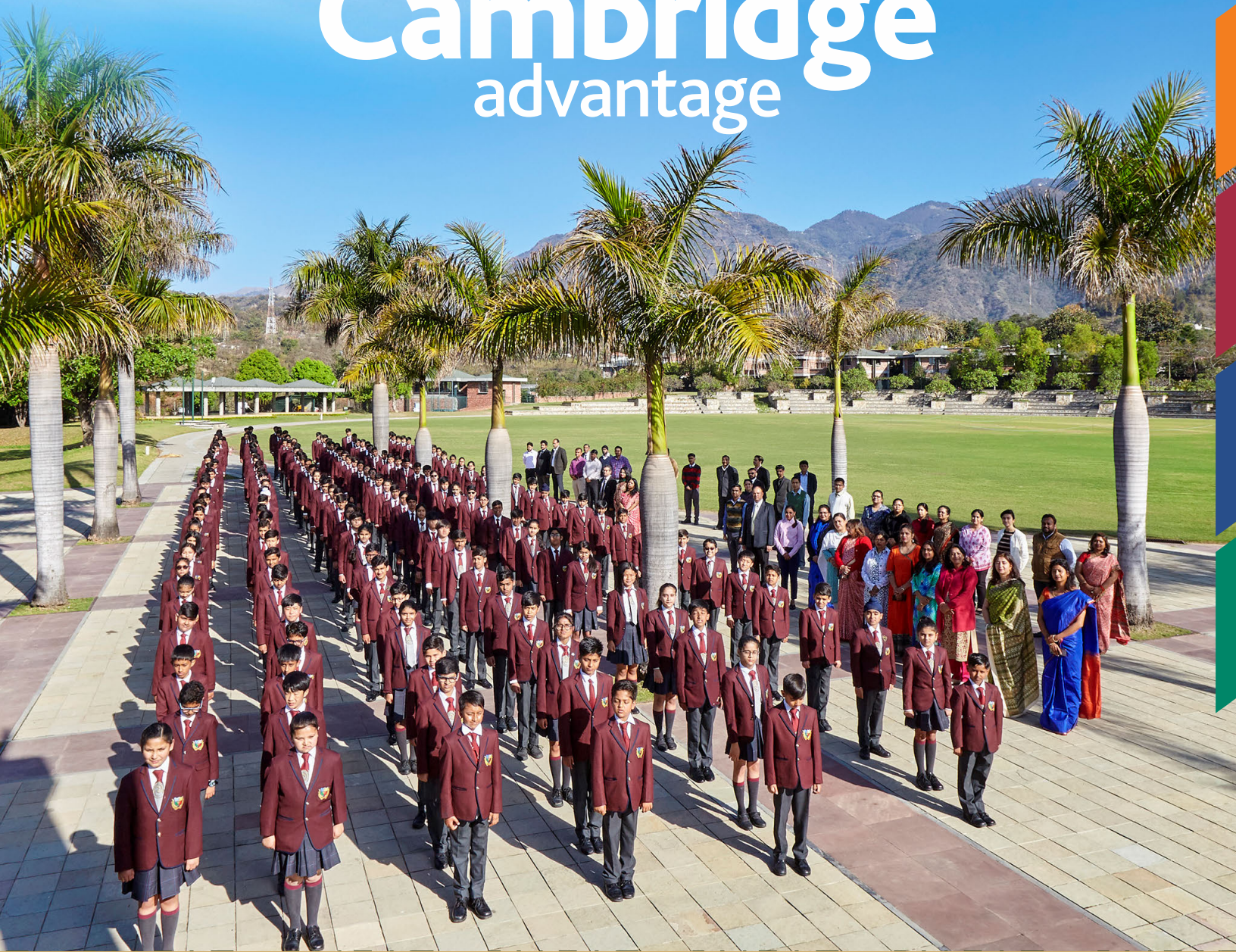

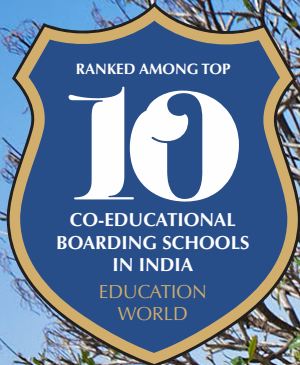

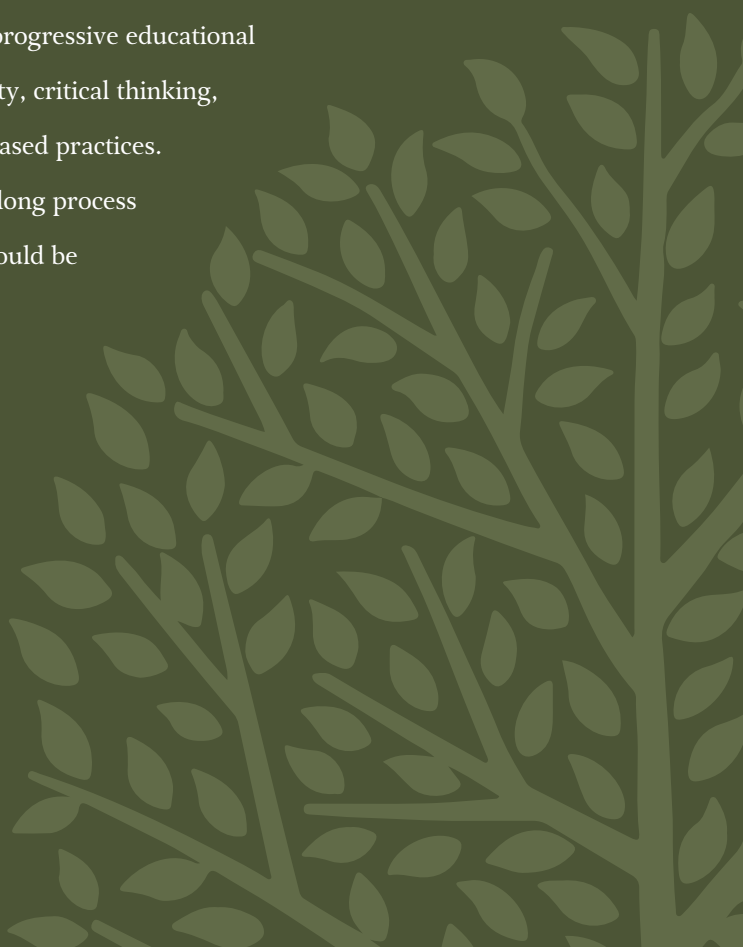


Welcome to the Cambridge International Program at KĀSIGA

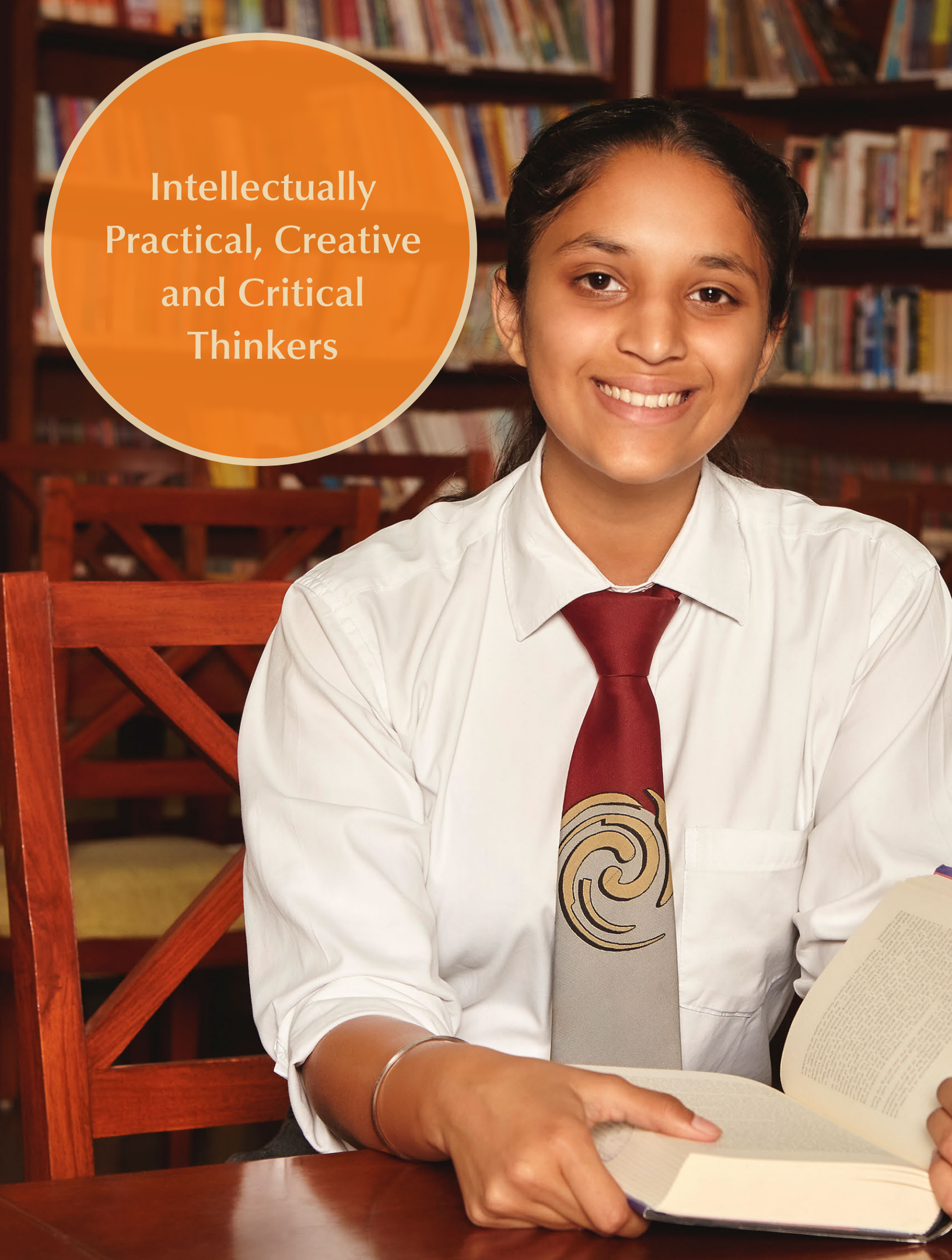

The Curriculum

Kāsiga School offers the IGCSE and the AS / A levels that correspond to grades 9 & 10 and grades 11 & 12 of the Indian schooling system.

IGCSE

Kāsiga School offers 18 subject choices at the IGCSE level in a program that spans across 2 years in grade 9 and grade 10. Students are required to study all the compulsory subjects and choose optional subjects to study a minimum of 7 subjects and a maximum of 9 subjects. Compulsory subjects include one syllabus option for English, one additional language, one syllabus option in Mathematics, 3 Science subjects or a Combined Science option, from the following list.

CAIE Advanced International Certificate of Education

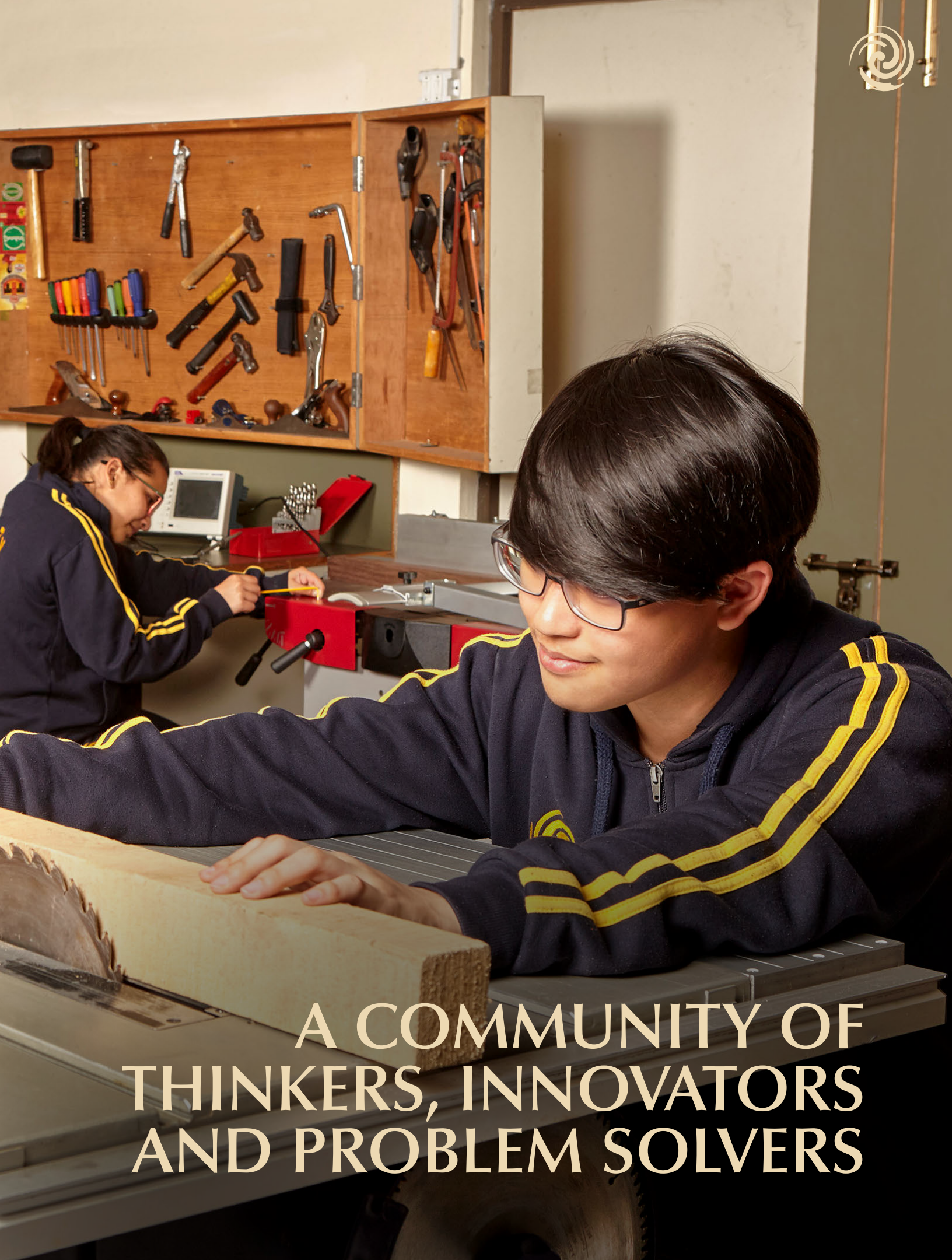
The CAIE AICE (Advanced International Certificate of Education) is a diploma certifying to a broad and balanced choice of syllabus options and is recognised by universities for its quality and depth.

Students study Cambridge International AS & A Levels across at least three subject groups as well as Cambridge Global Perspectives and Research.

Cambridge International Project Qualification (Cambridge IPQ)

- Develops research, reflection and communication, as well as higher-order thinking skills.
- Can be taken in addition to Cambridge International AS & A Level.
- Is assessed by Cambridge International and graded A* to E.
- Asks students to complete a 5000-word research project on a topic of their own choice.

Learn, Discover and Achieve with Cambridge Assessments & Examinations

CAIE board examinations are available in March, June and November with the March and June series being our main examination series for IGCSE and the AS / A level. Results for the exams are available in May (March series), August (June Series) and January (November series).

CAIE allows students to resit for specific syllabus options for grade improvement, should the candidate feel the need to do so. CAIE provides a Statement of results with Percentile uniform marks for all syllabus options that were examined, A general certificate of education with grades (A* to E for A Level and A* to G for IGCSE) and a migration letter that fulfils all documentary requirements for application to an Indian or foreign University.

Examinations in the CAIE curriculum are tailored specifically for each subject and divided into multiple components for each syllabus option.

Different types of examinations including long and short answers, multiple choice questions, practical experiments and project-based assessments are used to evaluate the students' academic and co-academic skills.

Teacher Training

Kāsiga School boasts of a vibrant teaching community with highly qualified teachers engaging with our students at every level. Teachers regularly attend Cambridge Face to Face and Online training events to ensure that they remain up to date with the latest syllabus content, assessment methodology and teaching methods. Many of our teachers are qualified Cambridge examiners & Teacher trainers.

Additional Support for other examinations

For students who aspire to further education in institutions that require standardized tests, Such as the SAT, ACT, IELTS, TOEFL, IIT JEE, NEET, CLAT and other exams, both in India and abroad, Kasiga offers special classes and reinforcement lessons for those examinations through tie ups with professional agencies. We also offer our students participation in international exams such as the University of Waterloo Euclid and Hypatia Math exams, University of Waterloo 'Sir Issac Newton Physics Test', competitions, and symposiums that allow them to develop and demonstrate their skills and abilities. We also provide opportunities for knowledge extension by mentoring them through a variety of online courses on organizations such as EdX.org, Coursera.org and many other such options. Some of these courses translate to college credits, scholarships, and better performance in their board examinations.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Checkpoint Examination?

It is an examination conducted by CAIE for students of Grade VIII. There are a number of ways in which Cambridge Checkpoint might be used; some of these are outlined below:

- To test students' strengths and weaknesses on entry to a school/course of study
- To use as a guide for setting/streaming
- To inform students /teachers/parents about suitable exam entries for students, for example to provide evidence about which IGCSE tier to prepare for
- To act as a basis for action planning between student and teacher
- To compare teaching groups over years

What are the benefits of IGCSE & AS/A levels, when compared with other board examinations that might be taken in classes X and XII?

The benefits of CAIE qualifications, when compared with other examinations:

- It is an international examination with world-wide status and credibility.
- It ensures a broad-based education, while encouraging a degree of choice.
- It encourages indeed, demands the questioning and develops key learning, problem-solving and investigative skills by encouraging an active, critical and questioning approach to study rather than relying on rote learning.
- Students who have taken the IGCSE programme will be familiar with the styles of learning and the expectations of the IBDP (if they would like to change the Board after grade X)

Can students opt for the Cambridge curriculum in grade 9 (IGCSE) or Grade 11 (AS) if they have completed the previous class with any other board?

Yes. Provided that the student clears the school entrance examination for the CAIE curriculum and has a valid certificate of passing at the previous class from any other recognized board / School.

Can a student shift to CBSE or ISC after taking IGCSE in IX and X?

Yes, it is possible for students to shift from Cambridge curriculum to Indian curriculum. It is recognized by CBSE, CISCE and State Education Boards in India as a qualification for entry to class XI or for other higher secondary education courses.

IGCSE is also treated as equivalent to a class X qualification for admission to undergraduate courses in India.





How does Cambridge curriculum help with National Level Competitive Examinations?

The Cambridge curriculum exams include Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) that can help students with their competitive exam preparation. International schools provide as much rigorous training in academics as traditional curricula, but with a more holistic approach. Cambridge gives students many different ways to show their learning, including written exams, practical, orals and coursework.

Do Indian Universities accept IGCSE and AS/A Levels?

As per the AIU (Association of Indian Universities), Minimum 5 passes at IGCSE including English with Grade A, B and C and minimum 2/ 3 passes at A level examination of the British examining bodies is equivalent to +2 stage qualification which is the minimum eligibility requirement for admission to Bachelor degree programmes at Indian universities.

How can a student confirm that the university they are applying to accepts the CAIE qualifications?
